## Weekly Window - Trinity Sunday

The festival of the Trinity is celebrated in the Anglican church, on the first Sunday after Pentecost. Trinity Sunday marks the Christian doctrine of the Trinity, that we know as the three Persons of God: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. In 1162 Thomas Becket was consecrated Archbishop of Canterbury on the Sunday after Pentecost and eight years later, martyred in his own Cathedral.
