The draft plan can also be viewed in the Allen Room of the village hall. Printed copies of the questionnaire are available in the Allen Room, and at the Co-Op, Farleigh Hospice Shop and A G Smith Butchers Shop.

For Boreham to retain its identity as a village, distinct and separated from Chelmsford by protected open space, and to develop in ways which protect our environment and are supported by our local residents, businesses and organisations, it is important to have a clear plan into the 2030s. A **Neighbourhood Plan** is a community-led framework for guiding the future development of an area, allowing the community to influence change.

The above poster invites us to comment on our draft Neighbourhood Development Plan, which you can peruse in the Allen Room of Boreham Village Hall. Scanning the QR or using the Internet links above will take you to the **Questionnaire** for your views and responses. These are available in hard copies at the Co-Op, Farleigh Hospice Shop, A.G Smith Butcher's Shop.

The consultation period ends on 10th November, so do have your say!
