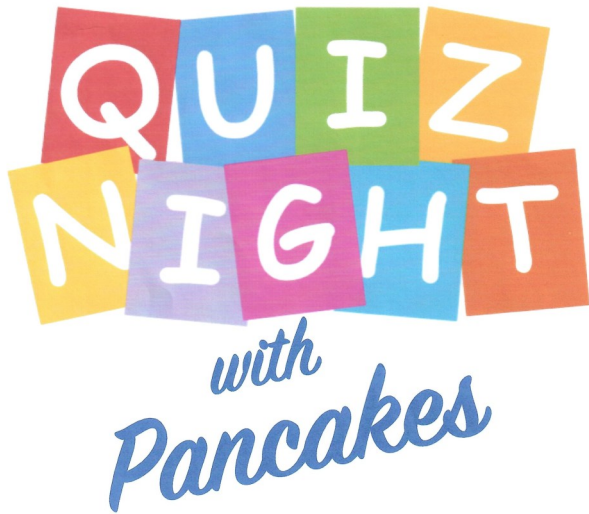
***If Candlemas Day be fair and bright,
