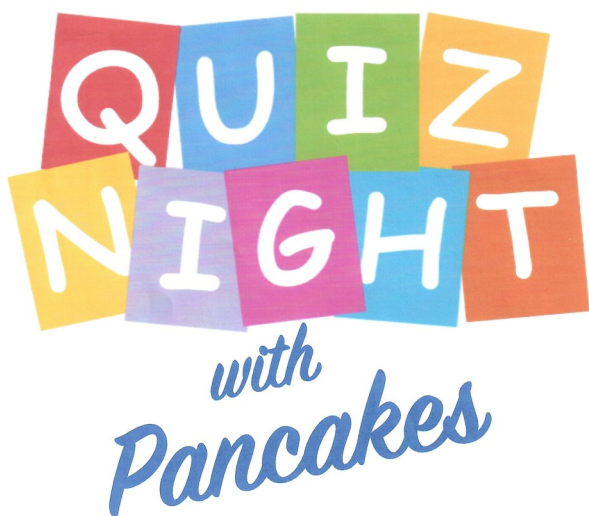
Ash Wednesday Service in Sacred Space at 6.00pm
