Dear all

I am very pleased to be able to provide an update on the project which will help us start to set some dates and targets

We have now been invited by the NLHF to submit a first application to them for the capital works and community programme. This is a significant milestone. It means that they like the sound of our project and that it has potential to receive their funding

Now that we have reached this milestone, we are going to work towards getting a bid submitted by 17th August 2023. The NLHF has quarterly set deadlines for grants at this level and this is the most realistic deadline for us. Submitting a bid then would give us a decision in December 2023

This is the biggest boost to the project to date, but there is a significant amount of work to be done, details of which and next steps I will be sending round over the next couple of weeks as I put together a full programme of actions

Reaching this stage will see more communication about the project but will also require more involvement from everyone involved. I'll be sending round a suggested project management and governance plan in due course, all of which will be discussed at a meeting which I will also send round dates for shortly

I hope this update brings encouragement and allows us to start to pick up some pace and momentum on this journey
